The USCCB Committee on Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations assists bishops in promoting, supporting, and educating about the Church's pastoral needs and concerns for the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life. The Committee is made up of a cross section of bishops, seminary rectors, permanent deacons and vocation directors. Along with the Leadership Conference of Women Religious and the Council of Major Superiors of Men, CMSWR is invited as an observer to the Committee's annual meeting in November. In preparation for this year's meeting the attached document, "On the Eucharist and the Church" was sent to us with the request that we ask our members to reflect on the questions raised and offer feedback to the Committee. In sharing the questions for reflection, the Committee noted that, "We are grateful for your prayerful reflection on this topic because it gives the bishops of the Committee a privileged opportunity to hear from a wide field of the Church about the state of Eucharistic faith in our country". What will be particularly helpful is if you can offer reflections on the questions as they relate to the people you serve in your particular missions.
