Dear Mothers and Sisters,

I hope that you, your sisters and those you care for are safe and doing well in these challenging times.

As you know, we postponed the Eucharistic Congress that was scheduled to be held in Philadelphia in October. At its recent meeting, the Executive Committee of the Board decided to cancel the Congress in favor of encouraging local and regional Eucharistic devotions, e.g. Eucharistic processions, Forty Hours devotions, parish Holy Hours, etc. In these uncertain times, this local and regional focus - which eliminates the need for extensive travel - could do much to enliven the faith of the people in the areas in which we live and serve.
