On September 11, 2020, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and the Resource Center for Religious Institutes (RCRI) issued a new joint memorandum to clarify the standards for determining the employment status of men and women religious performing services for Catholic organization employers, as well as the US Internal Revenue Service (IRS) taxation and reporting obligations with respect to compensation paid for such services.
