Dear Mothers and Sisters,

UPDATE ON THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR POSITION

In light of our experience of functioning during the pandemic, **we are exploring the possibility that the position of Executive Director can, to a significant degree, be fulfilled remotely.** There are periods of time when the Director must be physically present, eg. for events like the Formators' Workshop and National Assembly and for meetings with other individuals and groups, but there is a significant portion of the Director's responsibilities that can be accomplished remotely. As we noted previously, the position will become vacant as of December 23, 2020. In light of the significance of this position to the functioning of the Council, we are asking you to prayerfully consider having one of your sisters apply for the position.
